LabelPal is used in packhouses throughout New Zealand and processes over 3 million cartons of apples a year. While LabelPal has its roots in the pipfruit industry, it is now used for processing within other sectors of the produce industry, such as asparagus and stonefruit.

LabelPal allows you to enter the information for the pallet card once the pallet is completed and then can print both the pallet card and carton labels as required.

Run information set up at start of run.

Client details preset.

Minimum information is then required to produce the pallet card and labels.

- Completely User definable pallet card layouts and label layouts. Print what you want or need without restrictions to a set layout.
- Fast label generation using the label printers native language.

LabelPal is licenced according to which features the packhouse uses. The basic system allows pallet cards and carton labels to be generated, as well as having the EDI features for generating loadouts.. More advanced users can generate reports using our reporting program “Datapack” which includes

- Pack Report – size and grade distribution, product split and packout for a run, grower etc.
- Table Reports – a versatile reporting system that allows the user to choose what information they wish to see. Summarises information as well.
- Spreadsheet Report – pallet details shown in a spreadsheet like grid with numerous filtering and printing options.
- Piitsa Output – enables data to exported or imported using the industry standard PIITSA formats.

LabelPal requirements:

- IBM PC compatible computer (min. 1GHz, 256 MB RAM) running Microsoft Windows XP, capable of running at a minimum screen resolution of 1000 x 768.
- Suitable printer for Pallet Cards
- Suitable Label Printer. (Optional)
